

INJURY INSURANCE FOR PLAYERS

Insurance

Registered players are covered for personal injury suffered while participating in netball or a netball related activity, such as training, by the Netball Australia insurance policy. The policy provides financial assistance with medical expenses not covered by Medicare and loss of income.

Injuries should, where possible, be reported, by the player or their parent or carer, to an NCNC official on the day the injury occurs. NCNC officials can usually be found in the pavilion at either venue (Lyneham or Charnwood).

Making a Claim

To make a claim the player, or their parent or carer, will have to lodge a Netball Australia claim form and may have to complete an NCNC Sports Injury Incident Report.
